

**TILDEN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

Saturday, October 3, 2009  
Budget Meeting

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building for the purpose of preparing the 2010 budget, with the following present: Supervisors Russell Werley, Judy Romig and Troy Hatt, Township Secretary, Cheryl Haus, and Township residents Roy & Anna Shollenberger.

The budget meeting commenced at 9:29 A.M.

Discussion on the following items was held:

- A. A charge to the tax collector for office space
- B. Fire Protection
- C. Additional plowing, etc. (additional charges for state roads during emergency rerouting)
- D. Auditor change
- E. Possibility of a Resolution to PSATS for the county convention regarding reimbursement payments for fire company responses on Interstate highways (I-78 corridor). Troy Hatt will contact Kenny Grimes
- F. A fire tax for 2010
- G. Increased millage for 2010
- H. Real estate exonerations for elderly for 2010

Budget items were each discussed with changes made to the following:

**410.040 Crossing guard** Upon observing the number of students / parental involvement at the West State Street (Westy) school bus stop, the Board decided to delete the Crossing Guard salary for 2010.

The secretary will prepare the budget several different ways for the Preliminary Budget meeting on November 7, 2009. Differences will include:

- A. Implementing a fire tax and deleting emergency services from the General Fund Budget
- B. Additional patrolmen (full-time / part-time)
- C. Second full-time person for the road department
