Ordinance No. **234-2018**

AN ORDINANCE OF TILDEN TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A STOP INTERSECTION AT THE INTERSECTION OF MOUNTAIN AND PINE ROADS IN THE TOWNSHIP; AUTHORIZING TILDEN TOWNSHIP TO PLACE A STOP SIGN AT THE EASTERN APPROACH ALONG MOUNTAIN ROAD AT THE INTERSECTION OF MOUNTAIN AND PINE ROADS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION, AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS OR PARTS THEREOF

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Tilden Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania is authorized pursuant to the Second Class Township Code to enact ordinances to protect public health, safety, and welfare;

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Board of Supervisors that the safety of the travelling public will be improved by the placement of a stop sign at the intersection of Mountain and Pine Roads, which is an intersection under the jurisdiction of the Board of Supervisors;

IT IS THEREFORE ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Tilden Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. Stop Intersection. An official stop sign shall be erected at the eastern approach to the intersection of Mountain Road and Pine Road, in such a position as to face traffic in the direction indicated. Every driver of a vehicle approaching the intersection shall stop the vehicle as required by the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, 75 Pa. C.S. Section 3323(b), and shall not proceed into or across the

intersection until he or she has followed all applicable requirements of that section of the Code.

Section 2. Fines and Penalties for Violation. Any person who violates any provision of this section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) and costs, in addition to fines, costs, and penalties prescribed by the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code.

Section 3. Signs Authorized. The Board of Supervisors is authorized to place stop signs of the form and type approved and authorized by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT), in the manner required under PennDOT regulations.

Section 4. Ratification of Existing Signs. Any such signs currently in place are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 5. Severability. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors of Tilden Township that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

Section 6. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with this Ordinance.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective on the earliest date allowable under applicable law.
