Workshop

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Russell Werley, and Judy Romig, Roadmaster Mike Quick, Chief of Police Bill McEllroy, and Township Secretary, Cheryl Haus. The meeting was called to order @ 8:00 a.m.

Mike Quick, Roadmaster, discussed with the Board the need for a pipe replacement on Berne Road. Preliminary costs are approximately \$50,000.00. Mr. Quick also discussed paving Lowland Road to Mountain Road. Mr. Quick will look for a double/deep welled stainless steel sink for the concession stand.

An Executive Session before the meeting to discuss employees was held.

Chief McEllroy discussed with the Board the new radios and Promissory note just received from Berks County. Also, the rifles, brackets, ammunition, etc.

The status of flood insurance for pump station # 2 (West State Street) was discussed.

The possibility of using Tilden for Blood Bank Donations was discussed.

Supervisor Schappell will discuss with the Park & Recreation Board, the Application and Resolution for Park rentals.

Rental of the meeting room was discussed, making sure that renters know that cell phones do not get reception in the building.

A meeting with Township Engineer, Ron Tirpak will be set up to discuss the HMA 4th Addendum to the sewer Agreement.
