

**TILDEN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

Workshop

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building, for a Public Workshop, with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Russell Werley and Judy Romig, Township Secretary, Cheryl Haus. One guest was present. A copy of the roster is on file with the Secretary.

The meeting was called to order @ 8:03 a.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Police Chief Dennis Schwoyer discussed with the Board the need for an additional officer. Reports were given as to the number of calls, statistics from WalMart / Lowe's in other municipalities, busiest days of the week for calls and busiest hours of each day for calls. Discussion will continue at the next workshop.

Mike Cassidy of Focus Development (Holiday Inn Express) discussed with the Board fees for the building permit and a letter of support for grants Focus is applying for, a hotel tax and a possible amendment to the approved Land Development plan.

As per the motion made February 6, 2010, the Sewer Lateral Inspector will be required to (A) provide insurance as an independent contractor or (B) be employed by Tilden Township as an employee.

Agenda items were discussed among the Board of Supervisors. Computer off-site backup, sewer hook-ups and usage fee charges, a gift card for the set up of the township website, thank you to the road crew for the good job on the roads, caller ID for the office telephones and the sewer lateral @ 46 Berne Road.

Bids for the Emergency Generator were opened and read. Award of the bid will be at the Board of Supervisors meeting on February 6, 2010.
