Workshop

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Russell Werley, and Judy Romig, Roadmaster Mike Quick, Engineer Ron Tirpak, and Township Secretary, Cheryl Haus. Two residents were in attendance. A copy of the roster is available with the secretary.

The meeting was called to order @ 8:02 a.m.

Items discussed were police policies, letter requesting a higher donation of \$1,000.00 from the Animal Rescue League (the secretary will call the dog warden (to know who will respond to stray dogs) and Bliss Haven (regarding chips), a disability insurance program for the Tilden Township police (more information will be gathered—including from other municipalities and PSATS), the USPS bulk mail permit, a street light bill from the West State Street pump station property, and a wood burner @ 115 Marion Street.

Township Engineer Ron Tirpak entered the meeting approximately 8:45 to discuss the 4th Addendum to the HMA sewer Agreement, a residents hook-up to the Township sewer system and the Traffic Impact Fee Ordinance.
