

**TILDEN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

Friday, February 8, 2013  
Workshop

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Russell Werley, and Carl Spatz, Roadmaster Mike Quick, Chief of Police Bill McEllroy, and Township Secretary, Cheryl Haus. One resident was present.

The meeting was called to order @ 8:00 a.m.

Items discussed were

- ✓ February 14, 2013 agenda items
- ✓ Roadmaster Mike Quick told the Board that the contractors on Hill Drive, doing the PHMHP sewer connection, are approximately ½ way complete. They hit rock and construction is going slower at this point.
- ✓ Dave Gross discussed with the Board an exemption from the Outdoor Wood-Fired Boiler Ordinance. The Board stated Mr. Gross must install a line for hot water to the milk house and increase the stack to 15 feet, according to the ordinance, within 60 days.
- ✓ The Ordinance request from Hamburg Fire Company to obtain reimbursement for costs of materials expended and services rendered in fighting fires. Tilden Township Attorney, James Lillis is not aware of Tilden Township having the authorization to give to the Hamburg Fire Company to collect these fees. The secretary will contact Hamburg Borough and Windsor Township to see if they received this request.
- ✓ Stormwater Management fees. An amended fee schedule and application were discussed. A call was made to Engineer, Ron Tirpak, to explain the new fees.

No action was taken.

A motion was made by Russ Werley and seconded by Gene Schappell to adjourn the meeting @ 12:30 p.m. Werley, Spatz and Schappell voted yes.
