A 1999 Mack Tandem Lot Axel Dump Truck was purchased through the PennDOT on-line auction, in the amount of \$16,458.75.

REPORT-SECRETARY

The secretary's report For April, 2013 was given by Cheryl Haus. Permission was given by Commissioner Leinbach and Mr. Geffken to move the "Historic plaque and rock" @ the Berne Station Bridge, with the Township assuming liability for any damages. The secretary will contact the county to see if they have any plans to reincorporate the plaque / rock back into the plans.

Refund amounts of \$3,618.91 from MRM Worker's Compensation and \$3,520.24 from MRM property & liability pooled trusts, were received, and are based on 0 claims.

REPORT - PARK & RECREATION

A report from the April 17, 2013 meeting was received. Short term goals of the committee are: planting of trees, monitoring of trash / need of a dumpster, and better grass by planting seed, fertilizing and liming. Additional mulching, installation of a flagpole and some grass planting have been completed.

Long Term Goals include: dug outs, shed, scoreboard, batting cage, tractor / mower, back fence and lights.

Supervisor Russ Werley spoke with Donald Raezer and his place of employment is interested in donating stone or selling it at a minimal cost / installing the stone on the dugouts.
