Items discussed were

- ✓ June 13, 2013 agenda items
- ✓ Todd Landis discussed with the Board a vacant lot he owns @ 225 Berne Road. Mr. Landis purchased this lot from Met-Ed in approximately 1987, as an approved building lot, to build a home. He was then told by the township zoning officer he could not build a home because the lot was too small. Mr. Landis has three registered tractor-trailer trailers on the lot and has received a number of Notices of Violation, etc. from Tilden Township. Mr. Landis would like to put a pole building on the property. He will fill out an application to do so. In the event this is denied, he will go to the Zoning Hearing Board and request a variance.
