

TILDEN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Friday, February 7, 2014
Workshop

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Fred Herman and Carl Spatz, Chief of Police Bill McEllroy, Township Secretary, Cheryl Haus and Road Master Mike Quick.

The meeting was called to order @ 9:00 a.m.

Items discussed were

- ✓ Gene Schappell and the Board thanked Roadmaster Mike Quick and his road crew members for the cleanup of snow in Tilden Township.
- ✓ The use of Traffic Impact Fees to widen Pine Road from Clayton Avenue to Mountain Road and other possible projects was discussed.
- ✓ The Agility Agreement with PennDOT was discussed.
- ✓ Sewer capacity increases were discussed.
- ✓ The Reverse Trade Show on June 5, 2014 with Greater Reading Chamber of Commerce was discussed. The secretary will get more information.
- ✓ An invitation was received from the Hamburg Union Fire Company regarding Workers Comp for Volunteers. Supervisors Gene Schappell and Carl Spatz and Secretary Cheryl Haus will attend.
- ✓ The PSATS convention was discussed. Supervisor Gene Schappell will not attend. Supervisor Fred Herman, Mike Quick and Cheryl Haus will attend. Carl Spatz will decide.
- ✓ Supervisor Schappell asked about the status of the GIS mapping done by Derek Fair. Road Master Quick and Mr. Fair have been in touch, however, the snow has prevented Mr. Quick from getting together with Mr. Fair.
- ✓ Road Master Mike Quick and Chief of Police Bill McEllroy presented a quote done by RMI for two additional radios. Both these radios are obsolete and cannot be upgraded. One is the radio in the township office and the other is for the backhoe. The secretary will send a letter to Hamburg Borough requesting permission to allow Tilden Township to program Tilden Township radios with the Hamburg Borough frequency for receiving and transmission.
- ✓ The Blue Mountain Wildlife Quad races were discussed by the Supervisors and Police Chief Bill McEllroy.
- ✓ The secretary will contact Ron Tirpak, Township Engineer, for further clarification on the comments for the Cabela's proposed zoning request.
