

TILDEN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Friday, April 3, 2015
Workshop

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Carl Spatz and Fred Herman, Chief of Police Bill McEllroy, Township Road Master Mike Quick and Township Secretary, Cheryl Haus.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gene Schappell @ 9:05 a.m.

Items discussed were

- ✓ Edward & Carol Schaeffer attended the meeting to discuss connecting to the Township sewer line on Mountain Road. **A motion was made by Gene Schappell and seconded by Carl Spatz to allow Edward & Carol Schaeffer to connect to the Township sanitary sewer system upon approval by DEP of the Tilden Township Corrective Action Plan. Upon roll call, Schappell, Spatz and Herman voted yes.**
- ✓ Zoning / Building Officer, Bill Murphy, discussed with the Board some zoning / UCC residential requirements, etc.
- ✓ Flagger training was discussed. Both Mike Quick and Nick Gehringer are signed up for the May 6, 2015 training.
- ✓ Rental of a boom mower for approximately \$3,000.00 per week was discussed
- ✓ Purchase of a 2001/2002 F-550 bucket truck with a 40 foot lift for approximately \$20,000.00 was discussed.
- ✓ Welcome to Tilden Township signs
- ✓ 2015 Road Projects / bridge maintenance on Creamery Road
- ✓ Cinders / street sweeping
- ✓ Chemical spraying certification
- ✓ A pipe sticking up at 351 Lowland Road will be checked into
- ✓ Earth Day signs
- ✓ A request for a community project by Tyler Price was discussed. The student will be asked to come to the May 6, 2015 Board of Supervisors workshop
- ✓ The Outdoor Wood Boiler amendments were tabled.
- ✓ Chief McEllroy stated 11 applications for the part-time position had been picked up. Six applications were returned. 5 interviews have been completed. Chief McEllroy is now waiting to receive background checks back.
