

TILDEN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Workshop

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Carl Spatz and Fred Herman, Township Road Master Mike Quick and Township Secretary, Cheryl Haus.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gene Schappell @ 7:15 p.m.

Items discussed were

- The existing well @ 125 West State Street to use for pump station # 2. Cost to run lines, etc. with new pump \$5,500.00. The road crew will test the pump using a generator, etc. before a decision is made.
- The week of June 8, a boom mower will be rented to cut brush and mowing of the shoulders will begin.
- We will check with Lowe's to determine the best pricing to purchase lumber to build a pavilion at 125 West State Street
- Parking lot lights will be installed at the park. We have the poles, lights will be purchased.
- FREE movie nights will be held at Tilden Park on July 18 and August 15.
- PennDOT is looking to swap 1.3 miles of Olde 22 currently owned by Tilden Township for Bachmoll or Salem Church Road. More discussion will be held
- HB709 regarding imposing a fee on full-time and part-time State Police patrols of municipalities has been entered again for 2015.
- Supervisor Herman will work with the Police Chief to train on the Code Red System.

A motion was made by Carl Spatz and seconded by Fred Herman to adjourn the meeting @ 9:24 p.m. Schappell, Spatz and Herman voted yes.
