

TILDEN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Friday, December 4, 2015
Workshop

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, and Fred Herman, Township Road Master Mike Quick, Tilden Police Chief William McEllroy and Township Assistant Secretary, Stacy Degler and several residents. Supervisor Carl Spatz, Jr. was absent. The attendance roster is on file with the secretary.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gene Schappell @ 9:07 a.m.

Items discussed

- Vincent O'Domski, District Director for Congressman Charles Dent spoke to the board regarding services available to Township residents through Congressman Dent's office. He left materials for distribution to any resident in need of their services.
- Roadmaster Quick stated that vinyl for the new Township sign has been procured and will be installed when weather permits.
- Roadmaster Quick discussed the plan for the widening of Industrial Drive and the addition of a walkway.
- Supervisor Herman asked about the possibility of putting guiderail at the hard curve on Walnut Road near St. Mary Church. Roadmaster Quick said instead of guiderail being installed, he was considering extending the pipe and filling ground in at that location.
- Supervisor Schappell mentioned the need to move the next workshop meeting. Proposed date is Thursday, December 31, 2015. Once Supervisor Spatz has an opportunity to consider the date change, a motion can be made at the regular BOS meeting scheduled for Wednesday, December 9, 2015.
