

TILDEN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Friday, April 7, 2017
Workshop

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Fred Herman and Carl Spatz, Road Master Mike Quick, Police Chief William McEllroy, Township Manager/Treasurer Cheryl Haus and Supervisor's Secretary Bonny Conrad. The attendance roster is on file with the secretary.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gene Schappell at 9:05 a.m.

Issues discussed were:

- Chief McEllroy discussed an anti-aggressive pan-handling ordinance, an ordinance for fireworks and normal soliciting ordinance to all be done by Solicitor Joan London. Also discussed CPR recertification for May 2, 2017 and initial CPR certification for the Secretary to be determined
- Road Master Mike Quick discussed renting a loader at \$50.00/hr for grating the driveway up to the parking lot along with the embankment around the pole. Also discussed that the Hamburg Jaycees would like to sponsor a movie night and Nick will be on Workman's Compensation for 6 weeks. Mike will look into getting costs for paving the driveway and parking lot.
- Interviews were held for the three remaining applicants for the part-time mowing position to include 3 days a week until Nick returns but not to exceed 30 hours per week. Looking to hire at Board of Supervisors meeting on April 12, 2017
