The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Fred Herman; Absent: Richard DeLong; Chief William McEllroy, Assistant Secretary Lorraine Ramirez, Road Master Mike Quick and local residents. POLICE:

- Discussed and reviewed the current part time Road Crew Employees and they will be continuing as they are.
- Three Quotes were received for paving the entrance to the park and will be reviewed.
- Discussed possibly getting trees around park area, Mike will be checking with Lowe's.

- Looking for MiG Welder for Road Department
- Discussed getting pipe fixed on Willow Road.
