

TILDEN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Wednesday March 25, 2020
Emergency Meeting

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Fred Herman and Richard DeLong, Police Chief William McEllroy, Road Master Michael Quick, Township Secretary/Treasurer Monica Flower.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gene Schappell at 12:12 P.M.

A general discussion was held on each department and staffing. The Road Crew and the Office staff are operating on minimal staffing for daily and essential services; beyond that both departments are on-call for emergencies. The Police Department is operating as normal.
