The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Fred Herman; Chief William McEllroy, Manager/Secretary/Treasurer Monica Flower, and local residents. Absent: Richard DeLong & Road Master Michael Quick. The attendance roster is on file with the secretary.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gene Schappell at 9:06 a.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

GENERAL DISCUSSION:

- A discussion was held regarding an ordinance recently adopted by Upper Bern reducing the speed limit and weight restriction on Mountain Road. Upper Bern requested the Board of Supervisors consider a similar ordinance and/or grant Upper Bern permission to erect weight restriction warning signs within Tilden Township. This item will be on the agenda for the regular meeting.
- The corn on the corner of Pine and Laurel Road has now grown tall enough to cause a site distance safety issue. The Board of Supervisors cordially requested the property owner, Tom Werley, to clear the corn to improve the visibility. Mr. Werley responded that he would consider it. There was further discussion to possibly paint a stop bar at the intersection along with other options to encourage traffic to make a proper stop.
