The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Fred Herman and Richard DeLong; Chief William McEllroy, Road Master Michael Quick, Manager/Secretary/Treasurer Monica Flower, and local residents. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gene Schappell at 9:07 a.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

GENERAL DISCUSSION:

- Chief McEllroy reported on a complaint received from a resident on Clayton Avenue regarding more school zone signage and concern with speeding traffic. This complaint has been addressed by the Chief of Police, the Road Master and the Engineer.
- The Township Manager was contacted by Safety Net Sanctuary to solicit their animal control services for 2021. This was discussed in length as well as options to be offered by ARL. The ARL contract for 2021 has not been received yet.
- The Road Master reported the 2005 Ford Dump Truck sold for \$5,350.00.
- The toilet in the pavilion men's bathroom is leaking and will be replaced with a porcelain toilet.
- The road crew took time to hang the scoreboard at the baseball field which was donated by Sheetz. Baseball is responsible for hooking up the electricity.
- The Treasurer presented a 2019/2020 budget review comparison report to the board.
