

ORDINANCE NO. 129, 2000

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TILDEN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 79 OF 1990, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 86 OF 1991, PERTAINING TO THE CUTTING OF GRASS, WEEDS AND OTHER VEGETATION BY CHANGING THE REQUIREMENT DATES FOR SUCH CUTTING TO JUNE 30 AND AUGUST 31

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Tilden, Berks County, Pennsylvania, pursuant to the authority given to it to promote the health and welfare of the citizens of Tilden Township, and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 79 of 1990, as amended by Ordinance No. 86 of 1991, (collectively, the "Ordinance") is hereby amended in its entirety so as to hereafter read as follows:

"Section 2. Cutting of Grass, Weeds and Certain Other Vegetation Required. All persons, firms or corporations owning or occupying any property within the Township of Tilden, Berks County, Pennsylvania shall cut any or all grass, weeds or any other vegetation whatsoever not edible or planted for some useful or ornamental purpose, which throws off any unpleasant or noxious odor, or conceals any filthy deposit, or creates or produces pollen, on or before June 30 and again on or before August 31 of each year.

Section 2. Except to the extent to which this ordinance amends the Ordinance, the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect and is hereby ratified and reaffirmed.

Section 3. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Supervisors of the Township of Tilden that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after its enactment.


