

AN ORDINANCE BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TILDEN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 34, ADOPTED OCTOBER 1, 1973 AND EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 1, 1973.

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BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of the Township of Tilden, Berks County, Pennsylvania, that the Tilden Township Zoning Ordinance of 1973 enacted and ordained on October 1, 1973 and effective November 1, 1973, is hereby amended in the following manner:

ARTICLE I - DEFINITIONS is hereby amended to provide for a term, as follows:

48. MODULAR HOME. A single family dwelling transported to a site in two or more units and designed to be joined into one integral unit and constructed at the site on a full basement, having a minimum underclearance of 7'-0".

All Ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after the date of its enactment.
