

ORDINANCE NO. 86, 1991

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TILDEN AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 79, 1990, THE TOWNSHIP WEED CUTTING ORDINANCE, TO CHANGE THE APPLICABLE DATES FOR CUTTING OF GRASS, WEEDS, AND OTHER VEGETATION FROM JUNE 1 AND AUGUST 1 OF EACH YEAR TO JUNE 15 AND AUGUST 15 OF EACH YEAR IN ORDER TO COMPLY WITH THE CURRENT WEED MOWING CONTRACT OF THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

Section 1. Section 2 of the Ordinance No. 79 of 1990 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. Cutting of Grass, Weeds, and Certain Other Vegetation Required. All persons, firms or corporations, owning or occupying any property within the Township of Tilden, Berks County, Pennsylvania, shall cut any or all grass or weeds or any vegetation whatsoever not edible or planted for some useful or ornamental purpose, which throws off any unpleasant or noxious odor, or conceals any filthy deposit, or creates or produces pollen, on or before the fifteenth day of June and again on or before the fifteenth day of August of each year.

Section 2. All other provisions of the Ordinance No. 79, 1990, as amended, will continue in effect.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective in accordance with law.
