

ORDINANCE NO. 33 , 1972

AN ORDINANCE OF TILDEN TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2, 1964, EFFECTIVE THE SIXTH DAY OF JULY, 1964, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 31, 1972, EFFECTIVE THE TWELFTH DAY OF AUGUST, 1972, WHEREIN TILDEN TOWNSHIP REGULATED JUNK DEALERS, THE ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF JUNK YARDS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO AUTOMOBILE JUNK OR GRAVEYARDS, STORAGE AND DISPOSAL OF SCRAP, REFUSE, AND JUNKED ARTICLES, PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF LICENSES FOR JUNK DEALERS, AND FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF JUNK YARDS UNDER PRESCRIBED CONDITIONS, PRESCRIBING REMEDIES FOR THE ABATEMENT OF NUISANCES AND UNLICENSED JUNK YARDS AND SCRAP YARDS, PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATORS, AND PROVIDING FOR THE REVOCATION OF LICENSES IN THE EVENT OF NON-COMPLIANCE.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Tilden Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same and pursuant to the authority granted by the Legislature of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 2, 1964 AND ORDINANCE NO. 31, 1972, IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I-F - DEFINITION, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION I - DEFINITIONS, Unless otherwise expressly stated, the following words and phrases shall be construed throughout this Ordinance to have the meanings herein indicated:

- F. JUNKYARD. The word "junk yard" as used in this Ordinance shall mean any place or establishment where junk is stored or accumulated, on the outside of any building, edifice, or structure that is enclosed on all sides or where the business of selling, buying or dealing in junk is carried on, or where two or more motor vehicles are stored which are unlicensed, inoperable, and do not have a current and valid inspection sticker as required by the Motor Vehicle Laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania providing said definition shall not include the use of unlicensed and inoperable vehicles used for educational purposes by a charitable institution.

SECTION 2 - A NEW SECTION 2 IS HEREBY ADDED TO THIS  
ORDINANCE, AND SHALL PROVIDE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 2 - This Amendment to the Ordinance shall be-  
come effective five (5) days after enactment as provided in the  
Second Class Township Code.
