ORDINANCE NO. 73, 1989

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TILDEN AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 64 OF 1987, PERTAINING TO COMPENSATION OF TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS, TO PROVIDE FOR PAYMENT OF SUPERVISORS ON A MONTHLY BASIS RATHER THAN ON A PER MEETING BASIS

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has enacted Act 68 of 1985 setting forth certain guidelines and limitations for the compensation of supervisors of townships of the second class, and

WHEREAS, said Act provides that supervisors of townships having a population of not more than four thousand nine hundred ninety-nine (4,999) shall be compensated in an amount not to exceed Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500) per year, and

WHEREAS, the population of Tilden Township is approximately two thousand two hundred (2,200), and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly by Act 68 authorizes the boards of supervisors of the various townships of the second class to determine the compensation of supervisors subject to the limitations as set forth in the Act, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has previously passed that Ordinance No. 64 December 17, 1987 providing for the compensation of the Supervisors at the maximum allowable rate pursuant to Act 68 of 1985,

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Board of Supervisors of Tilden Township to set a payment schedule for compensation for the Supervisors on a monthly basis within the limitations of Act 68,

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION 1. Paragraph one (1) of Ordinance No. 64 of 1987, is hereby amended follows:

1. Each Supervisor of Tilden Township shall receive compensation for attending regular and specially scheduled meetings, preparing for such regular and special meetings, and for otherwise performing duties of the Office of Supervisor, at the rate of one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125.00) per month, beginning with the January 2, 1990, meeting of the board.

Paragraph three (3) of Ordinance No. 64 is deleted.

SECTION 2. All prior Ordinances of the Township of Tilden, insofar as they deal with the matters contained herein, are repealed and declared unenforceable insofar as they are inconsistent with or identical to any provision of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after the date of adoption.
