The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gene Schappell, at 7:00 P.M. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

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REPORT - POLICE

The report for July, 2014 was given by Chief McEllroy. 90 incidents were handled, 1,303 miles were put on vehicles and 95.2 gallons of fuel were used. Chief McEllroy attended his first B-CERT training and also had his first call out. All officers were trained on the new radios. An Agreement was signed with Berks County regarding reprogramming the radios with the county at no charge vs. Radio Maintenance reprogramming at cost. The Chief also discussed with the Board, Cody Express, which would allow Officers to do reports, print forms, etc. from the police cars. Cost of this would be approximately \$8,000.00.

Upon roll call, Schappell, Spatz and Herman voted yes.

A motion was made by Carl Spatz and seconded by Fred Herman to Authorize Chief of Police, Bill McEllroy, to request fire police for the Indian Fort Inn First Responder's Appreciation Day, on September 20, 2014 with a raindate of September 21, 2014. Upon roll call, Spatz, Herman and Schappell voted yes.

A motion was made by Gene Schappell and seconded by Fred Herman for Resolution # 14, 2014 to authorize Concord Public Finance to take the necessary steps to solicit proposals for the possible refinancing of the General Obligation note, Series of 2012, issued June 8, 2012, in the original principal amount of \$5,510,000.00. Upon roll call, Schappell, Herman and Spatz voted yes.

Discussion was held on the three-way stop at Mountain Road and Pine Road. Only one of the three stop signs have "Three-Way stop" under the stop sign. The secretary will note this for the Road Master.
