Workshop

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Fred Herman and local residents; Manager/Treasurer/Secretary Monica Flower; Chief William McEllroy and Road Master Michael Quick. Absent: Richard DeLong. The attendance roster is on file with the secretary.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gene Schappell at 9:13 a.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Participation:

- Dean Bucks was present to inform the Board of his plans to repair the soffit and roof at 56 Hill Drive. The Board agreed to a timeline of four month for completion.

General Discussion:

- 2022 Road project was discussed along with the Academy Road Bridge guiderail. The project will be presented at the regular meeting.
- Park Equipment was discussed and agreed to upgrade to an 8ft. Merry-Go-Round.

- The documentation and permit for DEP were received from Kohl Bros and forwarded to the Engineer for completion. The water system operators have found new vendors for supplies.
