Workshop

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Fred Herman; Absent: Richard DeLong; Assistant Secretary Lorraine Ramirez, Road Master Mike Quick and local residents. Absent: Manager, Secretary, Treasurer Monica Flower and Chief William McEllroy. The attendance roster is on file with the secretary.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gene Schappell at 9:08 a.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Police: None

Park & Recreation:

- Supervisor Schappell discussed getting more equipment for playground. Merry-go-round, seesaw, handicap swing as well as costs and possible fundraiser or letters to local businesses requesting assistance in the purchase of the equipment.
- Movie Night is set for 8/21/2021 at sunset. Tilden Baseball will be running concession stand. Event will be posted on Facebook and shared on Tilden Township social media accounts.

General Discussion

- Discussion was held regarding a gentleman that has to do Community Service/DUI Program. Projects such as washing police cars, planting flowers and miscellaneous jobs were discussed to complete 16 hours of work to be done. Mike Quick will coordinate service projects with the gentleman.
- Met-Ed bill for Meter #50000181143 located at 100 Industrial Drive was under disconnection for nonpayment from March 2021 when the water system was under Blue Mountain Water Co-Op. Account needs to be switched into the Tilden Township name and paid upon Manager's return from vacation.

- Supervisor Schappell discussed his concern with overgrown areas on the Bartram Trail. Road Master and road crew will mow where needed.
- A concern regarding the intersection at Industrial Drive and Old 22/Hex Highway white stop bar is faded. Road Master will repaint stop bars after purchasing paint.
- Discussion on Right of Way concerning vehicle parking and safety issues, Rentals and final inspections before sales of rental homes. Schappell requested discussion continue and be placed on Agenda for 8/11/2021 Regular Meeting to review ordinances with Solicitor.
- As of August 29, 2021 Act 65 of 2021 amends the Sunshine Law requiring townships to create and post meeting agendas on their township website and building 24 hours prior to each meeting for all boards and commissions.
