

TILDEN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Friday, May 6, 2016
Workshop

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Carl Spatz, Jr., and Fred Herman; Township Road Master Mike Quick, Tilden Police Chief William McEllroy and Township Secretary, Cheryl Haus. The attendance roster is on file with the secretary.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gene Schappell at 8:30 a.m.

Issues discussed were:

- The Board met @ Swamp Road to discuss flooding problems, then proceeded to Industrial Drive to discuss walking safety of residents.
- Chief McEllroy discussed employing different details of speed control within the township.
- Road Master Mike Quick discussed with the Board a concrete walking bridge across a stream on West State near Pump Station # 2. Mike will discuss this with the Township Engineer and PennDOT. Mike will contact the Hamburg Grange and see if they are still interested in planting flowers below the Welcome to Tilden Township signs.
- The Secretary will contact Blaize Stull about doing a picnic table or benches at the basketball court @ Rhoades Memorial Park as an Eagle project.
- Discussion was held regarding amending Ordinance 198, 2009 and U-Turns, stop signs and No Parking in areas of the Township.
- A hook-up to the Tilden Township Sanitary Sewer line from 1808 Mountain Road was discussed.
- Jane Meeks of the Berks County Solid Waste Authority regarding Act 140 will be attending the June 3, 2016 workshop.
- Berks County Planning Commission will be attending the June 3 workshop to discuss MS4 requirements.
