

**TILDEN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

Friday, August 7, 2015  
Workshop

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Carl Spatz, Jr. and Fred Herman, Township Road Master Mike Quick, Tilden Police Chief William McEllroy and Township Secretary, Cheryl Haus. The attendance roster is on file with the secretary.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gene Schappell @ 9:04 a.m.

Items discussed:

- Discussion was held on the Kernsville Dam property, DEP, The Rock, littering, parking, etc.
- Chief McEllroy discussed the ordering of the AED, the wrong one was received, the correct one has been shipped. Patrolman Dennis Schwoyer's last working day is today. He will be on payroll until August 22, 2015 using vacation time. Jose Quinones has completed all testing requirements and hire date is August 1, 2015. Surveillance cameras for the police, office, garage, etc. were discussed. Chief McEllroy will contact the supplier and get further quotes.
- Road Master Mike Quick discussed the water at the pavilion and the bacteria in it. He has been putting chlorine pellets in the well daily and RM Schaeffer Plumbing will install an ultra violet light in the next week. The secretary will check with Bright Signs, Orwigsburg for a quote on electronic / digital messaging for the Tilden Township sign on Hex Highway, which is in need of repairs. A letter will be sent to PennDOT requesting a road swap of Maple Drive and Berne Road for Olde 22 will be sent.
- **A motion was made by Fred Herman and seconded by Carl Spatz to approve the waiver request from Joseph Jurgielewicz of Section 701 requiring a financial guarantee for the Jurgielewicz single family dwelling. Upon roll call, Herman, Spatz and Schappell voted yes.**
- LED lighting and the Met-Ed double rebate for August was discussed.
- The second Outdoor movie night will be held at Tilden Park on Saturday, August 15, 2015. The license has been received. Hot dogs will be available for purchase.
- A copy of the court decision of the Clark vs. Fritz Outdoor Wood Boiler litigation will be requested.
