The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Fred Herman and Richard DeLong, Township Secretary/Treasurer, Police Chief William McEllroy and local residents.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gene Schappell at 3:35 P.M.

-The Township has received word of the Judges decision for the appeal on the warehouse. The Judge has ruled in favor of the Township. The Developer has 30 days to appeal.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss and make a decision regarding the 2019 ARL Contract for animal control in Tilden Township.

A Motion was made by Gene Schappell and seconded by Fred Herman to contract with ARL for 2019 paying a base fee of \$1,500.00 and a per service fee according to the contract, and to include a 30-day clause stating either party may submit a written notice to dissolve the contract within 30 days.
