The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Carl Spatz, Jr. and Fred Herman, Township Road Master Mike Quick, Tilden Police Chief William McEllroy and Township Secretary, Cheryl Haus. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gene Schappell @ 9:00 a.m.

Items discussed

- Charles Freidlander, Actuary for Tilden Township gave a presentation on the status of the Tilden Township Non-Uniformed Pension Plan.
- **THE MEETING WAS RECESSED FOR AN EXECUTIVE SESSION at 10:10 A.M. REGARDING PERSONNEL.**
- **THE MEETING WAS RECONVENED AT 10:28 A.M.**
- Tilden Township police were on duty Saturday, October 31 during the King Frost parade being held in Hamburg. Tilden Township did not have any occurrences. Officer Jose Quinones is continuing on field training and is doing a great job.
- Mike Quick, Road Master passed his pesticide test and is certified to spray pesticides in the Township. The West State Street Sewer extension main line has been completed and tested. Hook-ups are taking place. Greg Haas of Carbon Engineering will conduct a final walk-through in order to make the final payment to Madonna Enterprises. The Road Swap with PennDOT is moving forward. PennDOT has asked for a change on St. Michael's Road, from Township Road ending at Creamery Road to Township road ending at Salem Church Road. This is not a problem as Tilden Township plows this part already. Industrial Drive has been widened on the shoulder. Paving is being done on River Road on Friday, November 6. Lines were painted on Walnut Road. Repairs have been completed on the grinder pump station fence.
- The Supervisors do not have any comments on the zoning hearing being held on 8 Moonlight Drive.
- The request of an increase to the Animal Rescue League from \$1,000.00 to \$1,200.00 and the request for a \$125.00 donation to the Berks Crime Alert will be included in the budget for 2016.
- A new directory will be done in 2016. The last one was done in 2005. Costs will be paid for by ads from businesses. PRINT will contact all businesses.
