The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Russell Werley and Judy Romig, Acting Chief Bill McEllroy and Township Secretary, Cheryl Haus. Resident Donna Bausher attended.

The meeting was called to order @ 8:00 a.m.

The zoning hearing application of Loving Hands Day Care was reviewed.

Roadmaster Mike Quick attended to discuss the recently purchased roller and used salt spreader, Saturday's snow storm, Swamp Road, water condition on Industrial Drive and this week's tree trimming on Academy Road.

An inquiry regarding a dog groomer / kennel? on Lincoln Drive was discussed.

More complaints regarding WalMart truck delivery signs were received.

There were no questions on the proposed 2012 budget.

Chip Haws, Solicitor for HMA attended the meeting to discuss the refinancing of the 2006 sewer bonds. HMA has passed a Resolution to move forward with the refinancing as long as the savings is above \$150,000.00 (including costs). There will be no extension to the maturity date.

Judy Romig, Supervisor discussed her meeting with committee members regarding the International Fire Code and the inspection program. Code Official Anthony Merklinger reviewed the committee's comments and responded that he is not clear on the intent of the suggestions and if the ordinance is not going to be enforced, he recommends appealing the ordinance.

Judy Romig, Supervisor relayed to the Board members the meeting of the Berks County Sewer and Water Regionalization Study.

The Board discussed the draft sound cannon ordinance.

The Board discussed the draft Outdoor Wood Burner ordinance. The discussion was tabled needing more information.
