

**TILDEN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

Friday, December 14, 2012  
Workshop

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Russell Werley, Gene Schappell and Carl Spatz, Jr., Roadmaster Mike Quick, Police Chief Bill McEllroy and Township Secretary, Cheryl Haus. Two residents were present. A copy of the roster is available with the secretary.

The meeting was called to order @ 8:00 a.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Items discussed were:

- ❖ HMA / Tilden Sewer Agreement. The Board would like to approve the Agreement at the January meeting.
- ❖ Steven & Bethanie Gordon attended regarding their woodstove. The Gordon's will complete raising the stack on their stove by the January 7, 2013 meeting.
- ❖ Roadmaster Mike Quick discussed back-up pumps for the pump stations. **A motion was made by Russ Werley and seconded by Gene Schappell to authorize the purchase of one pump for the Industrial Drive pump station at the cost of \$7,200.00, as provided by CW Sales Corporation. Upon roll call, Werley, Schappell and Spatz voted yes.** The sewer project of hooking up the Pleasant Hills Mobile Home Park was discussed. Hill Drive will be closed, for safety reasons, during the complete project. One ice sensor will be purchased for one of the salt / plow trucks.
- ❖ The tax collector rate will stay the same, 5% of collections.
- ❖ \$20,000.00 will be taken from the building / zoning fund for deposit into the Non-Uniformed Pension Plan and \$6,000.00 will be taken out of the building and zoning account for the new police mobile computers.
- ❖ A letter will be sent to the Zoning Hearing Board for the Cigars International hearing stating the Board of Supervisors do not have a problem with the items being requested by variance.

The meeting was adjourned @ 11:30 a.m.
