

TILDEN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Friday, March 8, 2013
Workshop

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Russell Werley, and Carl Spatz, Roadmaster Mike Quick, Chief of Police Bill McEllroy, and Township Secretary, Cheryl Haus. One resident was present.

The meeting was called to order @ 8:10 a.m.

Items discussed were

- ✓ March 14, 2013 agenda items
- ✓ Wade Havens-Bliss Farms discussed with the Board about his replacing an existing mobile home with a newer one. A new footer was installed as recommended by the BCO, and the electric pole was moved. Mr. Havens will provide Tilden Township with a plumbing letter from L & M Plumbing, an electrical inspection by Met-Ed and a letter from the mobile home company regarding tie down straps. The Township BCO will be asked to do an inspection as is done for other mobile homes in Tilden Township. Since this will be used for Agriculture, there will be no charge.
- ✓ Revisions to the building / zoning fees were tabled until the April workshop
- ✓ Route 61 (Port Clinton) road project-removing telephone poles-possible Tilden request for them
- ✓ Revisions to the Wood-Fired Boiler Ordinance were tabled until the April workshop
- ✓ Roadmaster Mike Quick discussed the following items with the Board:
 - A switch for the lights in the pavilion ceiling
 - A batting cage provided by Tilden Baseball
 - 2013 paving projects-Lowland Road, Laurel & Pine, Jetson Drive, Hill Drive and various road patching
 - PHMHP sewer extension
 - Replacing auger motors out of Snow & Ice account
 - April 5 auction @ the Reading Fairgrounds
- ✓ Chief of Police William McEllroy discussed with the Board the pothole on Dave's Way. A letter will be sent to Wendy's
