

TILDEN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Friday, July 6, 2012
Workshop

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell and Russell Werley, Roadmaster Mike Quick, Police Chief Bill McEllroy and Township Secretary, Cheryl Haus. A copy of the roster is available with the secretary.

The meeting was called to order @ 8:03 a.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

- ❖ Gene Schappell provided a check back to the Historical Society for \$216.00 in payment of the dumpster for the 125th Anniversary from Nester's sanitation. Nester's has donated the \$216.00 back to the Township
- ❖ Phil Harmon of R. J. Hall Company explained to the Board of Supervisors the current pension distribution to Non-uniformed employees of \$20.00 per year of service for pension benefits. It was suggested by Mr. Harmon to change the dollars per year of service to a percent times number of years service times average of salary for the last three years of service. This would be an increase of the township's responsibility for the Non-Uniformed Pension Plan. The Board can ask the Actuarial to prepare a cost analysis, giving closer figures at a cost of \$600.00.
- ❖ Eileen, Tim and Matt Luckenbill discussed with the Board the denial of their variance by the Zoning Hearing Board.
- ❖ The Board discussed the return of two park rental cancellations.
- ❖ The Board discussed the roofing permit charge and did not come to a decision regarding a fee.
- ❖ Anna Shollenberger, on behalf of the Historical Society, thanked Mike Quick and LeRoy Strunk for helping to get work done at the Park / concession stand for the 125th Anniversary. Over 350 people attended and the Anniversary was a huge success.
