The Tilden Township Board of supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Fred Herman; Absent: Richard DeLong; Assistant Secretary Lorraine Ramirez; Township Solicitor Joan London.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gene Schappell at 1:03 p.m.

Special Meeting Notice was advertised in the Reading Eagle on Thursday, September 19, 2019.

A discussion was held by Project Manager Richard T. Rezer from T.Y.LIN International and Kelly R. Sartori, Project Engineer from Pennoni that included the review and execution of Traffic Signal Approval from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation. SR-61 Northbound to Eastbound lane entering I-78 will be eliminated. SR-61 Westbound to Southbound lane entering I-78 will also be eliminated at the expense of PennDOT. Traffic Signal and SR-61 improvements were reviewed. Gene Schappell questioned if a warranty on Traffic Signal and components, they will be getting information on this.
