Special Meeting

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Fred Herman and Richard DeLong, Township Manager/Secretary/ Treasurer Monica Flower, Road Master Michael Quick and local residents. Absent: Chief William McEllroy. A copy of the roster is on file with the secretary.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gene Schappell, at 3:59PM. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

NEW BUSINESS

- A Motion was made by Fred Herman and seconded by Richard DeLong to accept the resignation of Thomas Walters, Jr. as of September 10, 2021.
- A Motion was made by Fred Herman and seconded by Gene Schappell to hire Dale Hartz as a full-time road crew member effective October 4, 2021 at the starting rate of \$18.00/hour with a 90-day probationary period and with the condition of obtaining a CDL license within six months; at which time a \$.50/hour increase will be granted. Upon roll call Schappell, Herman and DeLong voted yes.
- A discussion was held in great length concerning Kelly Toyota's current land development project, stormwater drainage easement, future projects for Kelly Hyundai and Planning Commission's imposed requirement for an agreement to be drawn and executed within 10 days from their meeting held on September 21, 2021. The Board of Supervisors are not in support of the additional requirement imposed and did not take any action; therefore the requirement is annulled.
