

**TILDEN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

Workshop

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Russell Werley, Gene Schappell, and Carl Spatz, Jr., Roadmaster Mike Quick, Police Chief Bill McEllroy and Township Secretary, Cheryl Haus. A copy of the roster is available with the secretary.

The meeting was called to order @ 8:08 a.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

- ❖ 2013 MMO's were discussed and will be approved at Saturday's meeting.
- ❖ The billings of Watkins Architect, Ltd.(\$457.50) and Purcell Construction (\$7,818.00). The Purcell Construction bill will be paid, however, a letter will be attached regarding some shoddy construction. The Watkins Architect bill will not be paid. A letter will be sent regarding the building design, post construction services and the punch lists
- ❖ A letter will be sent to the Hamburg Fireman's Relief Association regarding the audit / letter from the Auditor General's office.
- ❖ The Hamburg Municipal Authority will be contacted regarding arbitration on the new flat rate of Tilden's flows to HMA.
- ❖ The new emergency services radios and the county promissory notes / agreements were discussed.
- ❖ A 6' fence along the first base line of the Tilden Park baseball field and Diamondtex was discussed. Quotes will be requested.
- ❖ The requests from the Historical Society regarding money and programs was discussed.
- ❖ The payment of tapping fees and construction of the hook-up to the Township sewer system, from the Pleasant Hills Mobile Home Park was discussed.
- ❖ Pricing was received from Chief McEllroy for a new police vehicle. A decision on purchasing a new vehicle will be discussed after the 2013 budget is prepared.
- ❖ Mike Quick, Road Master discussed: Selling the grader, Park & Recreation signs needing to be sealed, Reading Electric lightning strike of pump station # 2 and maintenance of 4 generators @ \$250.00 each, paving of a small section on Tilden Road and River Road, guiderails on Hill Drive, repair of the parking lot due to PennDOT's tar & chip project, and replacement of a concrete pipe on Berne Road.

No action was taken.
