

TILDEN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Friday, June 9, 2017
Workshop

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Fred Herman and Carl Spatz, Road Master Mike Quick, Police Chief William McEllroy, Township Secretary Cheryl Haus. The attendance roster is on file with the secretary.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gene Schappell at 8:30 a.m.

Issues discussed were:

- **A motion was made by Gene Schappell and seconded by Fred Herman to permit the Blue Mountain Academy Annual Fit Family 5K / 10K race on June 11, 2017, on Mountain Road from Mountain View Drive to Stone Road, providing residents and Township police have been notified. Future requests require a 45 day prior request. Upon roll call, Schappell, Herman and Spatz voted yes.**
- Chief McEllroy discussed with the Board new police vehicles, liability and property damage insurance for keeping a vehicle in the state shed at Kernsville, Act 600 and 12 years / partial pension vesting, Aggressive Panhandling and Fireworks ordinances.
- Road Master Mike Quick discussed replacing or repairing the grinder pump for the sewer, rental of a boom mower for work on various roads, for one week at a cost of \$2,200 for the mower and \$750.00 for hauling. \$2,950.00, and being paid for 2 weeks of comp time accumulated.

A motion was made by Carl Spatz and seconded by Gene Schappell to adjourn the meeting at 12:12 p.m. Spatz and Schappell voted yes.
