Workshop

The Tilden Township Board of Supervisors met in the Township Municipal Building with the following present: Supervisors Gene Schappell, Fred Herman and Carl Spatz, Road Master Mike Quick, Police Chief William McEllroy, Assistant Township Secretary Monica Flower. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gene Schappell at 9:08 a.m.

Issues discussed were:

- Trail Towing - requested to be given consideration to be called upon police emergencies when towing is needed. After discussion, Chief McEllroy said consideration would be given and he would look into how other townships are handling towing.
- Police Chief McEllroy informed that Manderbach Ford is not able to get pricing at this time for a new police vehicle.
- So far township police have cited 172 trespassers. Time spent and vehicle wear and tear were discussed.
